Community and Family Resources (CFR) is pleased to announce the addition of a new Mental Health Therapist to our Webster City team. Tammy Holmstrom, LMSW, IADC, is dually licensed in the state of Iowa to provide substance use and mental health treatment services. She graduated from Sam Houston State University with a bachelor's degree in criminal justice victim studies. She then received her master's degree in social work from the University of Northern Iowa, with an emphasis on trauma.

Tammy is available to provide comprehensive mental health evaluations and individualized therapy to individuals ages 5+. She is experienced in helping individuals with a wide range of concerns, such as depression, anxiety, and co-occurring substance

use disorders. She specializes in working with individuals who have experienced trauma and is able to teach individuals valuable distress tolerance and emotional regulation skills that can be applied in a wide variety of situations. Her therapeutic approaches include Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT), Solution-Focused Brief Therapy (SFBT), and Attachment Theory.

Tammy understands how both common and novel stressors can impact life, relationships, work, and family. She believes that therapy should be a place where you can show up as your true self with a therapist who supports you with compassion and honesty. She believes in meeting each person where they are and working with them at their own pace to achieve their goals.

Tammy is currently welcoming new clients from the community. She will see clients at CFR's Webster City office (500 Fair Meadow Drive) on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 AM-4:30 PM beginning September 10, 2024.
